2016 ELECTION

Results are based on telephone interviews with a random sample of -- 1,012 -- national adults, aged 18+, living in all 50 states and the District of Columbia, conducted March 16-17, 2016.

For results based on the total sample of National Adults, the margin of error is ± 4 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

For results based on the sample of -- 898 -- registered voters, the margin of error is ± 4 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

Interviews are conducted with respondents on landline telephones and cellular phones, with interviews conducted in Spanish for respondents who are primarily Spanish-speaking. Each sample of national adults includes a minimum quota of 60% cell phone respondents and 40% landline respondents, with additional minimum quotas by time zone within region. Landline and cell phones numbers are selected using random digit dial methods. Landline respondents are chosen at random
