Results are based on telephone interviews conducted June 1-22, 2023, with a random sample of 1,013 adults, ages 18+, living in all 50 U.S. states and the District of Columbia. For results based on this sample of national adults, the margin of sampling error is ± 4 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

For results based on the sample of 502 national adults in Form A and the sample of 511- national adults in Form B, the margin of sampling error is ± 5 percentage points.

For results based on the sample of 536 adults employed full- or part-time, the margin of sampling error is ± 5 percentage points.

For results based on the sample of 670 non-retirees, the margin of sampling error is ± 5 percentage points.

For results based on the sample of 343 retirees, the margin of sampling error is ± 7 percentage points.
