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Results are based on telephone interviews conducted January 2-15, 2025, with a random sample of 1,005<sup>2</sup> adults, ages 18+, living in all 50 U.S. states and the District of Columbia. For results based on this sample of national adults, the margin of sampling error is ±4 percentage points at the 95% confidence level.

For results based on the sample of 500-- national adults in Form A and the sample of 505-- national adults in Form B, the margin of sampling error is ±6 percentage points.

Interviews are conducted with respondents on landline telephones and cellular phones, with interviews conducted in Spanish for respondents who are primarily Spanish speaking. Each sample of national adults includes a minimum quota of 80G 435.52 Tm 0 g 0 4 0.000009T10 g s a minimum quo

random digit dial methods. Landline respondents are chosen random within each household on the basis of which member has the next birthday.

Samples are weighted to correct for unequal selection probability, nonresponse, and double coverage of landline and cell users in the two sampling frames. They are also weighted to match the national demographics of gender, age, race, Hispanic ethnicity, education, region, population density, and phone status (cell phone only/landline only/both and cell phone mostly). Demographic weighting targets are based on the most recent Current Population Survey figures for th/p
